

# LABORATORY DIRECTOR CLIA QUALIFICATION

At the CRI Symposium for Clinical Laboratories, physicians can obtain 20 CME credits to qualify as the laboratory director of a moderate complexity laboratory under CLIA'88. Physicians seeking laboratory director qualification must attend the specified sessions designated as the Lab Director Track. Those sessions provide the necessary CME credit and are instructionally designed with the lab director and corresponding responsibilities in mind.

# The sessions in the Lab Director Track are also a great refresher for acting laboratory directors!

## **CME CREDIT**

The Laboratory Director Track will offer CME as prescribed credits by the American Academy of Family Physicians. AAFP Prescribed credit is accepted by the American Medical Association as equivalent to AMA PRA Category 1 Credit<sup>™</sup> toward the AMA Physician's Recognition Award.
