

DIRECTIONS & REGISTRATION

From Harrisburg: From I-83 N, take exit 46A to merge onto I-283 S toward Lancaster/I-76/Pennsylvania Turnpike. Take exit 1A to merge onto PA-283 E toward Lancaster. Take the Oregon Pike/US-222/PA-501/Lititz Pike exit toward PA-272. Merge onto Chester Rd (Slight left to stay on Chester Rd). Turn left at Lititz Pike/PA-501. Continue to follow PA-501. At the square in Lititz, turn right at E Main St/PA-772. Linden Hall School will be on your right, after one traffic light. Parking is available at the Main Entrance.

From Philadelphia: Merge onto I-76 W via the ramp to Valley Forge (Partial toll road). Take the exit onto I-76 W toward Harrisburg (Partial toll road). Take exit 286 for US-222 toward Lancaster/Reading. Merge onto Spur Rd (Partial toll road). Turn left to merge onto US-222 S toward Lancaster. Take the PA-772 exit toward Rothsville/Brownstown. Turn right at Newport Rd/PA-772 (signs for Akron/Rothsville). Continue to follow PA-772. Turn left at PA-772/Rothsville Rd (Y in Road, traffic light). Continue to follow PA-772. This will become Main Street. Linden Hall School will be on your left. Parking is available at the Main Entrance.
